SCC DRESS CODE

It is expected that Members-regardless of age, and their guests will dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the setting of our Club.

SCC Golf Course & Driving Range

Permitted

- Hats, visors, or caps. The bill must be forward.
- Men and boys are to wear shirts with sleeves and collars (ie folded, blade and Merino mock style) or golf shirts. All shirts are to remain tucked in at all times.
- Appropriately tailored shirts (such as UNTUCKit or Tommy Bahama Styles) are allowed to be worn on the course in an untucked manner.
- Slacks and shorts that are designed to be worn with a belt.
- Ladies and girls are asked to wear collared shirts or blouses or golf shirts.
- Skirts, slacks, skorts, or golf shorts, up to five inches above the knee.
- Spandex, yoga pants or running tights, may only be worn under golf skirts or shorts.
- Golf (soft spikes only) or Tennis Shoes

Not Permitted

- Denim, blue or black jeans.
- Cargo shorts or pants with protruding pockets, cut offs, athletic shorts.
- Sweatpants or hooded sweatshirts.
- T-shirts, cropped tops, tube tops, tank tops, or halter tops.
- Bathing suits, tennis attire.
- Metal Spikes.

SCC Aquatics/Pool

Permitted

- Full-coverage swimwear befitting the family atmosphere at the Club must be worn.
- Coverups covering the entire bathing suit must be worn outside of the pool and pavilion area.
- Shirts and shoes are required in all Club Facilities except in the pool area and locker rooms.
- All children not fully potty-trained are required to wear a swim diaper at the pool.

Not Permitted

See through or risqué swimwear.

SCC Tennis & Pickle Ball Courts

Permitted

- Tennis attire.
- Covered swimming attire.
- Shirts with or without collars.
- T-shirts without offensive pictures or statements.
- Tennis shoes with non-marking soles are required.

Dining Facilities

SCC President's Room

Permitted

- Country Club or business casual attire. Country Club/Business
 Casual consists of a nice pair of slacks or jeans and a collared shirt or
 turtleneck sweater. For women, a casual dress, trousers, or an appropriate
 length skirt.
- Women or girls may wear brimmed hats, coordinating with their outfits- not golf hats.
- Shorts or long pants designed to be worn with a belt.
- Collared or collar band shirts with sleeves for gentlemen and boys are required.
- Denim must be in tasteful, clean, and in good condition free from frays, holes, rips or bleached.
- Footwear must be always worn.

Not Permitted

- Men and boys must remove hats, visors, or caps in all indoor areas.
- T-shirts, cropped tops, tube tops, tank tops, or halter tops.
- Tennis or workout attire.
- Sweatpants, Hooded Sweatshirts, or Jogging Suits.

Trophy Room

Permitted

- Country Club or business casual attire (see definition above.)
- Golf, tennis, and jogging outfits.
- T-shirts without offensive pictures or statements.
- Shorts or long pants designed to be worn with a belt.
- Denim must be in tasteful, clean, and in good condition free from frays, holes, rips or bleached.
- Men's and boys' shirts must have sleeves.
- Footwear must be always worn.

Trophy Room

Not Permitted

- Men and boys must remove hats, visors, or caps in all indoor areas.
- Cropped tops, tube tops, tank tops, or halter tops.

SCC Upstairs Patio

Permitted

- Country Club or business casual attire (see definition above.)
- Golf, tennis, and jogging outfits.
- T-Shirts without offensive pictures or statements.
- Dry bathing suit with appropriate pool coverup.
- Sweatpants and sweatshirts.
- Hats, visors, or caps.
- Footwear must always be worn.

EXCEPTIONS
